DIRECTIONS TO PINE LAKE CHRISTIAN CAMP:

From Ames, take I-35 north 20 miles to Hwy 175. Follow Hwy 175 east 30 miles to Eldora. At the Pine Lake State Park entrance east of Eldora go north 1/4 mile, then turn right into the Pine Lake Christian Camp. Approximately 1 hour drive time from Ames.
